



## **Women's Western Golf Association**

### 2021 Junior Championship Exemptions

Exempt players who wish to participate in the Championship must return their invitation and complete an official entry by the posted deadline of May 3, 2021.

Players in one and/or both of the following categories may be eligible for exemption into the 2021 Women's Western Junior Championship, providing: they meet the eligibility requirements under the ELIGIBILITY section of the entry form, and there are spaces available.

- (1) Player qualifies under categories A, B, C or
- (2) Player has received a formal invitation for a D-1 Special Consideration Exemption from the Women's Western Junior Championship Committee

#### **A. Exemptions based on WWGA Championships**

Women's Western Junior Championship:

- A-1 Any Champion.
- A-2 Match Play Finalist/Runner-Up since 2019
- A-3 "Sweet 16" qualifiers for match play (2019)

Women's Western Amateur Championship:

- A-4 Match Play qualifier (2020)

#### **B. Exemptions based on other Championships**

- B-1 U.S. Girls' Junior Match Play Qualifiers (2019)
- B-2 Host state's Girls' State Junior Champion (2019, 2020), oldest division
- B-3 Annika Invitational USA Presented by Rolex, top 5 finishers (2021)
- B-4 Rolex Tournament of Champions, top 5 finishers (2020)
- B-5 Rolex Girls Junior Championship, top 5 finishers (2020)

#### **C. Exemptions based on Rankings**

- C-1 Top 50 Golfweek Junior Girls' Rankings as of date of entry
- C-2 Top 50 Junior Golf Scoreboard Girl's Rankings as of date of entry
- C-3 Top 50 Rolex AJGA Girl's Junior Rankings as of date of entry
- C-4 Rolex Junior Girls All-America First Team (2020)

#### **D. Exemptions based on Special Considerations:**

- D-1 A limited number of exemptions, based on special considerations and/or written invitation, may be granted by the Committee. Requests for a special consideration exemption may be submitted to the Women's Western Junior Championship Committee by applying online.
